

## Round Robin Story Telling

### Happiness: Healthy Interactions

**Instructions:**

- Teacher divides the class into four groups.
- Each group will be given a paper.
- Teacher writes the first sentence of a mystery story on the board.
- Then, the first person in each group continues the story by writing the next sentence.
- Then, pass the paper to the second person, who will continue the story by writing the next sentence.
- The last person in the group has to conclude the story.
- Once all groups have concluded their stories, each group will read out their story.
- Students from other groups may give their opinions.

**Tips:****Language**

- Use the simple past/past continuous tense to write your story.

Opening sentence:	The puppeteer yawned and switched the lights off in his workshop.
1 <sup>st</sup> student:	In the darkness, the tick-tocking of the grandfather's clock was the only sound that could be heard.
2 <sup>nd</sup> student:	Suddenly, an eerie cackle cut through the silence.
3 <sup>rd</sup> student:	A puppet, which was sitting on the shelf, stood up slowly....
