

Debate Station

Responsibility: Abuse of Prohibited Substances

Instructions:

- Teacher divides students into groups of four.
- Teacher passes three cards in three stations around the classroom – ‘Agree’, ‘On the fence’ and ‘Disagree’.
- Teacher gives each group a debate question.
- Students discuss, and then a representative walks to the station that best describes their feelings about the topic.
- Each representative must give the reasons for their stance.
- After a topic is discussed, the teacher can give other questions related to the theme.

Suggested topics:

Performance enhancing drugs should be legalised in sports.

Athletes should be allowed to take drugs to improve performances if they wish to do so.

Drugs in sports is unethical.

Sports idols should have squeaky clean images.
